

CBC Ministry Internship Program

The CBC Ministry Internship is a 10-month immersive program designed to equip future ministry leaders through hands-on experience, focused training, and intentional mentoring.

Who should apply for the Ministry Internship?

The Ministry Internship is for men and women who desire to serve in the local church, learn more about what it's like to work in ministry, discover and develop their giftings, and discern a calling to vocational ministry.

When does the Ministry Internship take place?

The program begins in August 2023 and will conclude in May 2024. Applications are accepted through April 15, 2023 and placements will be made by the end of May 2023.

What are the requirements for interns?

Interns will be paid staff members of CBC (\$12/hr) who are expected to work 20 hours/week. Interns are required to attend weekly intern training meetings on Tuesdays from 2:00–3:30 p.m. and are encouraged to attend weekly CBC staff meetings on Tuesdays from 11:00–11:45 a.m.

What can interns expect from CBC?

CBC will provide interns with 10 months of training in vocational ministry. Interns will be placed in a ministry department with a staff supervisor who will work closely alongside them, providing them with opportunities to serve and lead. In addition, interns will meet with a ministry mentor who will help them walk closely with Jesus through their time in the program.

What ministry departments can interns be placed with this year?

For the upcoming year, interns will be placed in one of the following ministry departments: Nursery, Students, College, Women's Ministry, and Equipping. Placements will be determined based on CBC's needs and the passions/skillset of each intern.

2023–2024 Opportunities

Nursery

CBC Kids exists to help parents gather and grow by providing a safe space for children to learn big truths about God, and gives volunteers the opportunity to become more Christ-like through service. The Nursery Internship is specifically focused on providing child care for families with young children, newborn to four years old. Tasks will include preparing classrooms, coordinating volunteers, and managing child care for various ministry events.

Students

“Some plant seeds of the gospel and some water them but God brings the growth” (1 Corinthians 3:5–7). Student ministry is all about the hard work of planting and watering seeds of the Word in students’ lives and trusting God with the growth in His timing... but there is more to student ministry than meets the eye. The student ministry internship is designed to give you a fuller picture of all that goes into student ministry, grow you in your ability to minister to students, and give you hands-on ministry experience. You will have the opportunities to help plan and execute student ministry Gatherings and events, learn how to complete some of the administrative/logistical tasks that it takes to run a student ministry program, disciple students, and help care for adult volunteer leaders.

College

Join the college ministry team on campuses, in the city, and around tables as we equip the saints for the work of ministry through evangelism and discipleship. This internship will focus on growing spiritually, planning and executing strategic events, and investing in college-aged individuals to be ministers of reconciliation in their current spheres of influence as well as the cities they will be sent to after graduation.

Women’s Ministry

The women’s ministry intern will have the opportunity to work alongside the Women’s ministry director in areas of leadership training, counseling/discipling others, administrative tasks, problem-solving, and logistics. She will be directly involved in all areas of women’s ministries such as bible/books studies, discipleship-groups, 1-on-1 discipleship matching, WOW (Women of the Word), women’s conference, summer socials, and our Dinner for Eight events.

Equipping

Ephesians 4:11-12 says: “And Jesus gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ.” “Equipping” is a catch-all term that we use at CBC to describe the work of training and discipling people of all ages to live as followers of Jesus. The Equipping Internship is unique as you will have the opportunity to work in various departments throughout the 10 months—mostly helping our Adult Discipleship Team carry out equipping events and efforts. Tasks will include event planning, volunteer recruitment, curriculum development, and more.
