Church Offices / Operations

- | In an effort to continue honoring the authority of our governing officials and do our part to minimize the potential spread of COVID-19, beginning tomorrow, Wednesday March 18th, the CBC Church Office will be closed through Tuesday, March 31st. While our facilities will be closed, operations will remain open as our staff team continues to work faithfully to serve the body of Christ. We have asked staff members that are able to work remotely to do so during these particularly unusual times. Office phones and email will be monitored during our regular hours (M-F, 9:00 a.m.–5:00 p.m.) should you need to contact us.
