

CBC KIDS COVID-19 POLICIES

We will have classrooms open with limited spaces available. The Nursery Classrooms will be open for both the 8:00 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. services and Elementary Classrooms for the 9:30 a.m. service only.

Nursery Classrooms offered:

Babies (0–11 months): 6 child limit

Splashers (1 year olds): 8 child limit

Waders (2 year olds): 8 child limit

Divers (3 year olds): 8 child limit

Kayakers (4 years olds): 8 child limit

Elementary Classrooms offered (9:30 a.m. Service Only):

Kindergarten: 8 child limit

1st Grade: 8 child limit

2nd Grade: 8 child limit

| All children will be registered and checked in online before services, this way CBC will have stickers printed ahead of time. We will not be accepting walk-ins.

Nursery Kids

| The children along with one parent will be escorted through the door marked “CBC Kids” and stop at the table in the nursery lobby where they will be given their child’s sticker after answering a few questions and then will be directed to their classroom where the child’s temperature will be taken at the door.

| After dropping off their child, parents will continue down the hallway and out the doors that lead to 69th street and re-enter through the Main Sanctuary doors for the service.

| To pick up children, parents will go down the hallway past the CBC Kids check in area, and proceed to their kid’s classroom, and exit out the 69th street doors.

Elementary Kids

| The children along with one parent will be escorted through the door marked “CBC Kids” and proceed to the stairway by the CBC Kids check in area and check in at the table upstairs. Volunteers will answer contact questions, have temp checked, and grab a mask. Parents will have temp checked and grab a mask (kids not required). Please stay to the right of the hallway while dropping your children off.

| After drop off, stay to the right, and follow the hallway. At the classroom door, parents will answer contact questions and kids will have temp checked.

| Exit via the short hallway across from the Jr Explorer room and go down the outside metal stairway and re-enter through the Main Sanctuary doors for the service.

| To pick up children, head back to the stairway by the CBC Kids check in and follow the same directions as for drop off.

**All volunteers will have their temperatures checked, wear masks, and will be asked to wash their hands before they enter classrooms.*

Here are some additional safety measures we will be taking:

- | All parents dropping off and picking up children are required to wear a mask.
- | There will be no more than 10 people in a classroom, including volunteers.
- | Bathroom monitors will be disinfecting bathrooms between each use.
- | We will not have snack time or allow any food to be served, with the exception of bottles in the babies classroom.
- | 99.5 is the temperature limit and anyone with a higher temp will be asked to leave.
- | Gloves will be worn while changing diapers, assisting in the bathroom, wiping noses, or dealing with any bodily fluids and will be changed after use with each individual child.
- | Each classroom will have plenty of hand sanitizer.
- | Toys, chairs, and surfaces will be cleaned between services.
- | Anything that is put in a child's mouth will be removed after use so that other children cannot come in contact with it.
- | Elementary Classrooms have moved in order to utilize larger spaces.
 - | Kindergarten is in previous Pre-K room
 - | 1st Grade is in previous Kindergarten room
 - | 2nd Grade is in previous activity room across from the Jr Explorer room
